CERTIFICATION

In cases of blindness, visual handicap or physical handicap, certification may be made by doctors of medicine or osteopathy, ophthalmologists, optometrists, registered nurses, professional staff of hospitals and public or welfare agencies. In the absence of any of these, certification may be made by professional librarians or by any person whose competence under specific circumstances is acceptable to the Library of Congress.

READING DISABILITY CERTIFICATION: Must be by a doctor of medicine or osteopathy who may consult with colleagues in associated disciplines.
